**Q1** How do you think we should elect the President: should it be the candidate who gets the most votes in all 50 states, or the current electoral college system? <i>Republican</i> .....	29%
<i>Other</i> .....	24%

**Q5** If you are white, press 1. If you are African American, press 2. If Hispanic, press 3. If other, press 4.

<i>White</i> .....	80%	<i>Hispanic</i> .....	7%
<i>African American</i> ...	10%	<i>Other</i> .....	3%

**Q6** If you are 18 to 29 years old, press 1 now. If you are 30 to 45, press 2. If you are 46 to 65, press 3. If older than 65, press 4.

<i>18-29</i> .....	13%	<i>46-65</i> .....	35%
<i>30-45</i> .....	19%	<i>Older than 65</i> .....	32%
