**AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE TO ENTER INTO A COMPACT WITH OTHER STATES TO
HAVE THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES ELECTED BY POPULAR VOTE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to authorize the state to enter into a compact with other states that provides for the election of the President of the United States by popular vote rather than by the electoral college.

Statement of Purpose:

To assure election of the President by popular vote.
